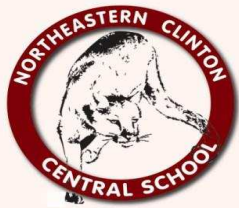

5. Students will not leave the building to go to their vehicle during the day without authorization from administration (must use sign-in/out sheet)	Verbal Warning	5-day suspension from driving	2-week suspension from driving
6. Students will follow all safe driving practices and adhere to the maximum of 10 mph on school grounds	Parent notified	2-week suspension from driving	Extended loss of driving privileges
7. Students will not leave school grounds at anytime during school hours without administrative permission	Parent notified, loss of driving privileges	Extended loss of driving privileges	Driving privileges terminated
8. Students will not smoke or allow others to smoke in vehicle while on school grounds	Parent notified, referred to Police	2-week suspension from driving, Police	Driving privileges terminated, P.
9. Students will prominently display their parking permit	Verbal Warning	Parent notified	2-week suspension from driving

10. Students understand by signing this application they are consenting to and will permit a search of their vehicle upon request by an administrator	Driving privileges suspended indefinitely		
11. In emergency situations, practice or real, students are not allowed to leave school grounds in their vehicle and must follow approved safety protocol for all students.	Driving privileges suspended indefinitely
