

Fulbright Sends Brazilian Administrators to visit NCCS

The Fulbright Teacher and Administrator Exchange program has been run by the US government since its creation in 1945. The mission of Fulbright is to “provide the opportunity for future leaders to observe and better comprehend the cultures and societies of other countries and peoples”.

During the week of November 16 – 22, 2008, three administrators from public schools in Brazil will be visiting the North Country. NCCS we serve as the host site for these administrators.

The goal of this visit is for the Brazilian administrators to learn more about how public education is conducted in America. It will also be an excellent opportunity for the staff and students to learn more about life and education in a foreign country.

During their visit, the Brazilians will visit all of the schools in the district as well as some other local school districts. They will attend classes, go to extracurricular events, and shadow administrators.
