Statement of Understanding

As a junior applying for permission to drive to school, I understand that there are specific rules I must follow in order to maintain and enjoy this privilege. If my application is accepted, I agree to follow the established procedures. Also, I am aware of the consequences if I violate any of the following procedures:

- 1) I will not arrive to school before 8:00am each morning
- 2) I will be in class by 8:20am and **NO LATER**
- 3) I will park in appropriate designated areas for student parking-**NOT curb-side or lawn**
- 4) I will not leave the building to go to my vehicle during the day without authorization from administration
- 5) I will keep my vehicle locked at all times
- 6) I will follow all safe driving practices and adhere to the maximum of 10mph on school
- 7) I will not leave school grounds at any time during school hours without administrative permission
- 8) I agree to park my vehicle and enter the building immediately upon arrival-  
**NO VISITING OR PLAY** in the parking lot
- 9) I will not smoke or allow others to smoke in my vehicle while on school grounds
- 10) I will prominently display my parking permit
- 11) I understand that signing this application I am also consenting to, and **will** permit a search of my vehicle upon request of an administrator.

Violations/Consequences

- \*\*\* Students in violation of #'s 1-7, 9 and 10 will serve a two week suspension of driving privileges following the third violation. The fourth offense will be a month suspension and additional violations could result in permanent revocation of driving privileges.**
- \*\*\* Students in violation of #'s 8 and 11 will serve a two week driving suspension following their first violation.**
- \*\*\* Students who violate school policy of the Student Handbook and are referred to the office for the following violations could serve a two week driving suspension following the second violation. Violations include: disrespect towards authority, inappropriate language or gestures, late for class, classroom disruption, and not serving ASD.**
