

Suggested UPK Supply List:

1. One box of 24 Crayola crayons
2. One box of 8 Jumbo Crayola crayons
3. A backpack large enough to hold a folder, sneakers, and a lunchbox - please do not purchase one with wheels as children tend to trip over them and they are difficult to store.
4. A complete change of clothes that your child can easily change into (shirt, sweatpants, socks, and underclothing) in a plastic bag (with the name on the bag) - in case of spills or accidents.

Kindergarten School Supply List:

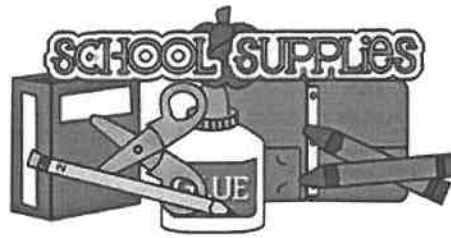
1. A box of 24 crayons
2. A pencil box (hard and approximately 8x5x2)
3. Scissors
4. Sharpened yellow pencils (please don't purchase pencils with plastic decorated covers since they break the sharpeners)
5. 2 black **low odor** dry erase markers with a **fine point**
6. 12 glue sticks
7. Sneakers and socks for Physical Education - We will let you know the days we have Physical Education at Kindergarten Orientation.
8. A backpack large enough to hold a folder, sneakers and a lunchbox - please do not purchase one with wheels (children tend to trip over them and get hurt). When choosing a backpack, please keep this in mind - Is your child able to open and close the zippers?
9. A complete change of clothes that your child can easily change into (shirt, sweatpants, socks and underclothing) in a plastic bag (with the name on the bag) - incase of spills or accidents
10. 2 boxes of tissues (We use one box at a time - this should be enough to get through the year.)
11. 2 packages of baby wipes

*** Please label the pencil box & scissors with your child's name!**

First Grade Supplies

1. Crayons – a box of 24
2. Box of pencils with erasers
3. Extra erasers
4. 1 Package of small glue sticks – We use a lot of glue!
5. One inch, hard covered, three-ring binder
6. Two boxes of tissues
7. Four low odor dry erase markers
8. 1 pair of scissors
9. A basic, plastic pencil box to hold these supplies
10. Sneakers for Gym days.

Suggested Supply List

- Sharpened pencils with erasers on top
- Erasers
- 10 glue sticks
- Crayons - no larger than a box of 48
- 8 low odor dry erase markers
- 1 clean cotton sock (to use as an eraser)
- Pencil box (8" X 6") average size only
- 1 marble composition books
- Scissors
- 3 boxes of tissues
- Backpack (bring one that fits in the lockers; wheels will not fit)
- 2 two-pocket folders (The PTP supplies one folder for students to start the year with and it will be necessary to replace it when it is no longer usable.)

You may bring the following to keep in your locker:

- A sweater or sweatshirt
- Sneakers for gym

Please do not bring unnecessary supplies; desk space is limited. Label all of your supplies with your first and last name and class. Please check with your child throughout the school year, to see if any supplies are running low.

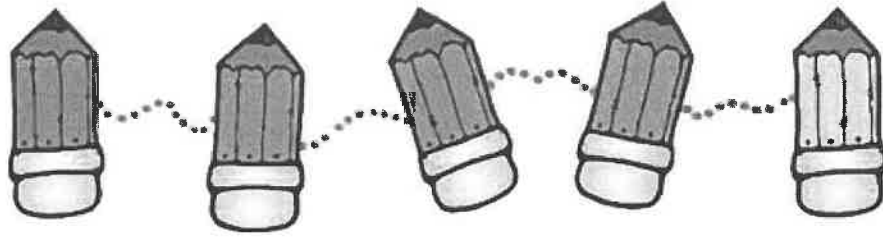

Since we have limited desk and locker space, please do not send in binders, trapper keepers, backpacks with wheels, or items that are not on the list.

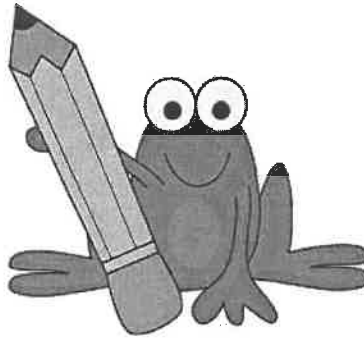

Suggested 4th Grade Supply List

- ❖ 4-Pack of Dry Erase Markers (low odor)
- ❖ 2 Boxes of Tissues
- ❖ 2 Boxes of Pencils
- ❖ 1 Box of Crayons or Colored Pencils
- ❖ 2 Highlighters
- ❖ 1 Package of Loose Leaf Paper (wide-ruled)
- ❖ 1 pair of scissors
- ❖ 1 package of glue sticks (4 in a package)

- ❖ Homework planners and take-home folders will be provided on the first day of school. Due to limited space in lockers and desks, students will not need any supplies that are not listed above.



5th Grade Suggested Supply List:

- ❖ 1 - Composition notebook
- ❖ 1 - Two inch 3 ring binder
- ❖ 4 - pocket folders
- ❖ 1- box of colored pencils
- ❖ 1- four pack of dry erase markers
- ❖ 2 - glue sticks
- ❖ 2- boxes of 12 pencils
- ❖ Pencil erasers
- ❖ 1- pair of scissors
- ❖ 1 - SMALL pencil box
- ❖ 2 - boxes of tissues (to share with the class)
- ❖ 1 - package of loose-leaf paper
- ❖ 1 - clean sock (for erasing white boards)
