

## UPK Supply List

- 1 pencil pouch (the soft kind for easy storage, as students do not have desks)

Please include the following items in the pouch

- 1 pair of small scissors (blunt end)
  - 1 small box of crayons (Crayola box of 8 basic colors)
  - 2 large glue sticks
- 2 two pocket folders
  - 1 package (at least 25) brown paper lunch bags
  - 1 large box of Kleenex
  - One full set of clothes – (pants, shirt, socks, underclothes, etc.), that can be left at school. Please put them in a zip lock bag and label with your child's name.
  - A school bag or backpack large enough to hold a folder, sneakers, and a lunchbox

(no fancy pencils – the pencil sharpener will not sharpen them)

  - 4 large glue sticks (out of package)
- Marble composition notebook
- A smock or an old large tee shirt (an old, large tee shirt is best because it covers front and back and does not need to be tied) for messy art projects
- 1 large box of Kleenex
- One full set of clothes – (pants, shirt, socks, underclothes, etc., that can be left at school. Please put these in a zip lock bag marked with your child's name)
- Sneakers for gym days with name/initials inside (If laces, please continue to practice tying at home)
- A school bag or backpack large enough to hold a folder, sneakers, and a lunchbox – please do not purchase one with wheels (children tend to trip and get hurt).

## PLEASE LABEL ALL OF THESE ITEMS

Please make sure all items your child brings or wears to school are **marked** with **their name or initials**. This is extremely important and cannot be stressed enough. Also, please DO NOT send special toys in with your child. The likelihood of them getting broken or lost is high.

Check your child's backpack the first day and daily thereafter. The first day you will find a copy of your child's schedule (which days they have art, gym, music, and library). There will also be important papers you will need to read, fill out, and return to school.

### **SCHOOL SUPPLIES FOR FIRST GRADE**

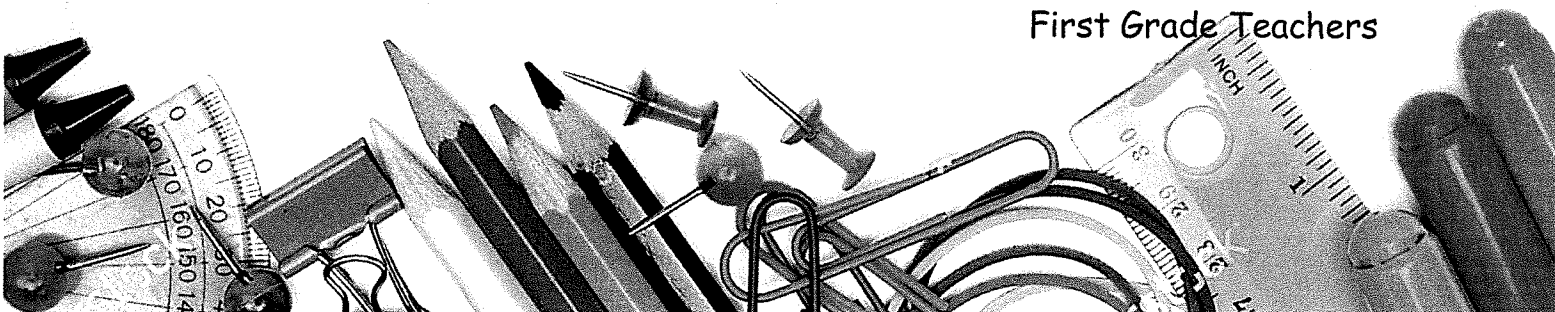
- A package of crayons

2 composition notebooks

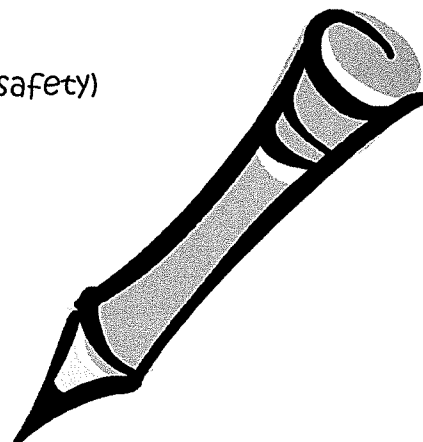
2 boxes of Kleenex
