

Due to strict state regulations, we must enforce tight controls on administering medications in our schools. In order for the school nurse to administer medications to students in school, the State Education Department requires all the following:

- 1. Medications in the original container from the pharmacy
- 2. Written parental permission to administer medication
- 3. Written order from the physician, including the medication name, dosage, duration of administration & side effects

Over-the-counter medications, (Tylenol, Advil, cough syrups, etc.), CANNOT be given by the school nurse without following the same instructions listed above. The State Education Department requires that no medications may be sent to school with the child on the bus.
